

Memory Club Requirements and Year End Testing

Club 50

- Memorize all 50 specified verses with a listener signing off throughout the quiz year.
 - In addition to the text of the verse, memorize the verse reference (book, chapter and verse number) for reference and quote questions in the quizzes.
 - It is recommended that 12 to 24 hours go by before reciting each verse (i.e. test the morning after memorizing a verse – this helps to ensure the quizzier is solid on the verse).
 - Verse(s) must be recited to the listener word perfect with no helps before the listener signs off.
- No year-end test required.
- Completion for Ribbon
 - The coach is to verify that the quizzier's club sheet has been signed by a listener for all 50 verses, signifying that the verses were recited word perfect to a listener without helps.

Club 150

- Memorize all 150 specified verses with a listener signing off throughout the quiz year.
 - In addition to the text of the verse, memorize the verse reference (book, chapter and verse number) for reference and quote questions in the quizzes.
 - It is recommended that 12 to 24 hours go by before reciting each verse (i.e. test the morning after memorizing a verse – this helps to ensure the quizzier is solid on the verse).
 - Verse(s) must be recited to the listener word perfect with no helps before the listener signs off.
- Pass the Club 150 Year End Test.
 - Place 150 verses in a hat. The quizzier randomly draws out 15 verses.
 - At the quizzier's choice, pick 5 as quotes and 10 as finish-the-verse.
 - During the test, the quizzier may elect to change between Quote and Finish-The-Verse (FTV) provided the first five words of the finish the verse have not been given.
 - Before attempting a quote, the quizzier may choose to substitute 2 FTVs in place of a required Quote (the quote in question would become one of the 2 FTVs). This substitution may be made for up to all 5 Quotes if desired. If one substitution is made, the quizzier must complete 12 FTV and 4 Quotes. If all 5 Quotes are substituted, the quizzier must complete 20 FTV and will not have to complete any Quotes.
 - If they choose FTV, the coach/listener gives the first five words of the verse. This does not count as a help.
 - The quizzier may have 3 free "helps" of up to five consecutive words during the entire test and should specifically ask for a "help".
 - At no time can a help be used for the beginning of the required 5 quotes.
 - Additional "helps" of five words could be earned by quoting more than the required 5 verses (as opposed to FTV) – 1 additional help for each additional verse quoted.
 - In place of a help, the quizzier may elect to trade one verse with one in the hat.
 - This test must be done in one sitting, but the quizzier may have as many chances to complete the test as the coach is willing to give.
 - Each of the tries would bring a different set of 15 verses "out of the hat".
 - If the coach limits how many attempts may be made to pass the test, it should be stated by the coach BEFORE the quizzier starts the first time.
- Completion for Ribbon
 - The coach is to verify that the quizzier's club sheet has been signed by a listener for all 150 verses, signifying that the verses were recited word perfect to a listener without helps.
 - The quizzier must pass the Club 150 Year End Test.

Club 300

- Memorize all 300 specified verses with a listener signing off throughout the quiz year.
 - In addition to the text of the verse, memorize the verse reference (book, chapter and verse number) for reference and quote questions in the quizzes.
 - It is recommended that 12 to 24 hours go by before reciting each verse (i.e. test the morning after memorizing a verse – this helps to ensure the quizzer is solid on the verse).
 - Verse(s) must be recited to the listener word perfect with no helps before the listener signs off.
- Pass the Club 300 Year End Test.
 - Place 300 verses in a hat. The quizzer randomly draws out 30 verses.
 - At the quizzer's choice, pick 10 as quotes and 20 as finish-the-verse.
 - During the test, the quizzer may elect to change between Quote and Finish-The-Verses (FTV) provided the first five words of the finish the verse have not been given.
 - Before attempting a quote, the quizzer may choose to substitute 2 FTVs in place of a required Quote (the quote in question would become one of the 2 FTVs). This substitution may be made for up to all 10 Quotes if desired. If one substitution is made, the quizzer must complete 22 FTV and 9 Quotes. If all 10 Quotes are substituted, the quizzer must complete 40 FTV and will not have to complete any Quotes.
 - If they choose FTV, the coach/listener gives the first five words of the verse. This does not count as a help.
 - The Quizzer may have 6 free "helps" of up to five consecutive words during the entire test and should specifically ask for a "help".
 - At no time can a help be used for the beginning of the required 10 quotes.
 - Additional "helps" of five words could be earned by quoting more than the required 10 verses (as opposed to FTV) – 1 additional help for each additional verse quoted.
 - In place of a help, the quizzer may elect to trade one verse with one in the hat.
 - This test must be done in one sitting, but the quizzer may have as many chances to complete the test as the coach is willing to give.
 - Each of the tries would bring a different set of 30 verses "out of the hat".
 - If the coach limits how many attempts may be made to pass the test, it should be stated by the coach BEFORE the quizzer starts the first time.
- Completion for Ribbon
 - The coach is to verify that the quizzer's club sheet has been signed by a listener for all 300 verses, signifying that the verses were recited word perfect to a Listener without helps.
 - The quizzer must pass the Club 300 Year End Test.

Club Full Material

- Memorize all specified chapters/scripture portions word perfect, with helps, with a listener signing off throughout the quiz year.
 - Quizzer must recite each chapter/scripture portion as designated by the club sheet.
 - Each chapter/scripture portion must be done in one sitting, but the quizzer may have as many chances to complete the test as the listener is willing to give.
 - If the listener limits how many attempts may be made to pass the test, it should be stated by the listener BEFORE the quizzer starts the first time.
 - The quizzer may have 6 free "helps" of up to five consecutive words while reciting each chapter/scripture portion and should specifically ask for a "help".
- No year-end test is required; however, we encourage those who learn all the material to participate in a public recitation of a portion of scripture (i.e. during a church service, youth event, family gathering, or school event).
- Completion for Ribbon
 - The coach is to verify that the quizzer's club sheet has been signed by a listener for all chapters and scripture portions, signifying that the chapters and scripture portions were recited word perfect to a listener with the maximum of 6 allowed helps for each chapter or scripture portion.
